- sleeps outside

Child and Family Services' Runaway and Homeless Youth Program, provides

- Information on the risks and realities of life on the street and what it means to be an estranged youth
- Emergency Safe Houses for youth who require a short cooling off period. The CFS group home may also provide emergency overnight care when appropriate
- Short-term, individual, family and/or group counseling can help to open communication, identify problems, set goals and find ways to achieve them
- Connects youth and their families to other resources in the community
- Helps to provide some basic needs
