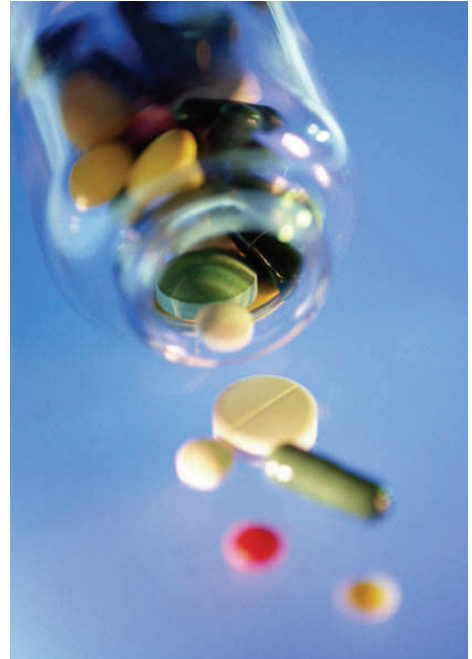


Prescription for Safety: Medication Abuse
